General Information

ARRANGEMENTS

Arrangements may be made at Trimble Funeral Home, where our dedicated staff is available to guide families through each step of the planning process. We recommend that, in addition to the information provided in the following pages, families bring items such as clothing, a photo of their loved one, cemetery deed, and relevant insurance documents to the arrangement meeting. Our funeral directors will work closely with the clergy to determine the best time and location for the service and will handle obituary placements in all requested local and out-of-state newspapers, using the details provided by the family. Prearranging with us can provide peace of mind and ensure that all wishes are carefully honored when the time comes.

SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS

With each service we provide, our team submits a "Statement of Death by Funeral Director" to the Social Security Administration. This statement initiates the process to stop Social Security payments. Currently, Social Security provides a one-time death benefit of \$255.00, which is available only to a surviving spouse or minor child. The surviving spouse or guardian of minor children must contact the Social Security Administration in person to arrange for these benefits. The local office is located at 129 Scott Station Rd, Jefferson City, MO 65109, and can be reached at 1-(877) 405-9803. VETERANS BENEFITS

All United States veterans who received an honorable or general discharge are eligible for certain non-monetary benefits, including an American flag, a government issued grave marker, and a burial space in the nearest National or State Cemetery for the veteran and their spouse. Our services include assistance with these claims, which will

require the veteran's DD-214 or comparable discharge documentation. Additionally, some veterans may qualify for extra monetary benefits. For more information, we recommend scheduling an appointment with the Missouri Veterans Commission at 1500 Southridge Dr., Room 300A, Jefferson City, MO 65109, by calling (573) 522-4223, or contacting the National Veterans Affairs Office at (800) 827-1000.

DEATH CERTIFICATES

The Death Certificate, certified by the State of Missouri, serves as a legal document needed to file claims, transfer asset ownership, or continue Social Security benefits for a minor. Most institutions require a certified copy, as photocopies are often insufficient. Currently, Missouri charges \$14.00 for the first copy and \$11.00 for each additional copy of the Death Certificate. If you need additional copies later, our staff will be available to assist.

INSURANCE CLAIMS

Our team is available to help with filing insurance claims as well. Most insurance providers allow beneficiaries to assign some or all of the policy's benefits to the funeral home to cover funeral expenses. It's essential to ensure that the policy's beneficiary information is current and updated as needed.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff . . \$3,465

This fee for all essential services includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial requests for service; arrangement conferences with family or responsible party; filing of necessary death records, authorizations; and permits; placement of obituary notices; planning of funeral arrangements; and coordination with clergy, musicians, cemetery, crematory, vault companies, and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses such as professional licenses, real estate and property taxes, insurance, maintenance, utilities, secretarial and administrative expenses, and equipment and inventory expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.

Embalming of Remains \$995

Embalming is the scientific preparation and sanitary care of the body for the protection of public health by state licensed professionals using universal precautions. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you

do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it such as direct cremation or immediate burial. It is our policy to require embalming when it becomes a practical necessity for public health and/or aesthetic reasons. Such necessity is determined by specific circumstances surrounding each death.

These charges for a direct cremation (without visitation or funeral) include staff services; local transfer of remains to funeral home; sanitizing of remains; obtaining legal authorizations; the cremation process itself at our facility. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use alternative container.

Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are constructed of corrugated cardboard and meet our crematory requirements.




